CBA ARTICLE XI: PLAYER RELATED EXPENSES

SECTION 1: LODGING

During the regular season and playoffs, players have two options for housing in their team's home city.

TEAM PROVIDED HOUSING

Players without children receive a one bedroom apartment.

If a player has a child or children under age 13 who live with them for all of or a significant amount of time during the season, they receive a two bedroom apartment.

If a player wants to upgrade to a larger unit and there is a unit available, if they provide advance notice to the team they can upgrade as long as they pay the difference between the cost of the team provided apartment and the larger unit.

The WNBPA can notify teams **on or before March 15** if they want to conduct an inspection of team provided housing.

MONTHLY HOUSING STIPEND

Players can opt to receive a housing stipend instead of team provided housing to put towards housing of their choosing. The monthly stipend varies by season and by city. For the 2024 season the monthly stipends are listed below:

IMPORTANT NOTES:

If you have entered into a player contract on or before March 15 for the following season, you must let your team know which housing option you would like by April 1

All other players must notify the team **within 14 days** of th execution of their Player Contract.

Neither the WNBA nor any Team may impose restrictions as to who can visit players in either of the housing options listed above.

TRAVEL

When playing on the road, players traveling with the team are to be provided with individual hotel rooms in first-class hotel accommodations.

TRAINING CAMP

Players are to be provided- at sole discretion of the team- with team-provided housing, monthly housing stipend (same amount as listed above), or individual hotel rooms.

SECTION 2: RELOCATION EXPENSES

For every season during which players are under contract to play in the WNBA, they will receive a coach airline ticket from the city where she permanently resides to the city of her assigned team.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

A coach airline ticket means- if available on the flight chosen by the team- a premium economy (or similar enhanced coach fare) ticket.

If a player's permanent residence is within 200 miles of the team's city no airline ticket will be provided. The team will reimburse the player for their ground travel expenses if they are documents and shared with the team.

In order for expenses to be reimbursed, they must be pre-approved in writing by the team.



IF A PLAYER IS REASSIGNED MID-SEASON

The player will receive a **coach airline ticket** from her prior team's city to her new team's city.

The player will be reimbursed for the **actual and reasonable** costs of shipping her personal belonging from her prior team's city to her new team's city.

At the conclusion of the season she will receive a **coach airline ticket** to the city where she has her permanent residence.

For players reassigned prior to the mid-point of the regular season reimbursement may include up to \$1,000 for the shipmet of one automobile.

WHEN A CONTRACT IS TERMINATED

The player will receive a **coach airline ticket** back to the city where she permanently resides.

SECTION 3: MEAL EXPENSE ALLOWANCE

MEAL EXPENSE ALLOWANCES

Players will be provided with a per day meal expense allowance while playing for their teams when they are "on the road" and during the training camp period.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Players are considered "on the road" from the time her Team leaves its home city until the time her team arrives back in its home city.

If the team directly pays for players' meals the players will not recieve the meal expense allowance.

"Home city" includes the city where the regularly used team facility for hoome games is located and any other location where home games are played as long as they are within 75 miles of the city.

Teams must provide players with written breakdown of specific meals included in their meal expenses allowance payments.



IF A TEAM IS "ON THE ROAD" FOR LESS THAN A FULL DAY

No meal allowance for breakfast if you depart after 9:00am OR arrive before 7:00am

No meal allowance for lunch if you depart after 1:00pm OR arrive before 11:30am No meal allowance for dinner if you depart after 7:00pm OR arrive before 5:30pm

NUTRITION COUNCIL

The parties will work together to form a "Nutrition Council" with appropriate representation from the WNBA, the WNBPA, Team, Player, and Corporate Partner representation to discuss:

- Proper nutrition to optimize athletic performance
- Reasonable guidelines (that consider cost and other applicable factors) in connection with any training tables that may be provided by teams.



SECTION 4: AIR TRAVEL

All air travel provided by the team (including but not limited to travel between games) will be, if available on team-chosen flights at the time of booking, premium economy (or similar enhanced coach fare)

IMPORTANT NOTES

Teams are required to reimburse players for the application cost of obtaining Global Entry membership as part of the Trusted Travelers Program of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

SECTION 5: GAME TICKETS

Each player will receive 2 complimentary tickets for each home and away game.



SECTION 6: LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

If a player does not have a car in the team market the team can:

- Provide the use of one car for every two players
- Reimburse the player the cost of shipping a car into and out of the team market up to \$2,000 (prorated as necessary if a player signs a rest-of-season contract or more than two weeks into the season)
- Reimburse the players cost of renting a car in the team market up to \$2,000
- Reimburse players for miles driven (based on the per-mile rate from the IRS guidelines) to up \$2,000.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Players must let teams know in writing at least 30 days prior to the start of training camp.
- The three options where players can get reimbursed up to \$2,000 are all to be prorated based on the amount of time the player is on the active list
- Players can get reimbursed up to \$240 during Training Camp and if they make the regular season roster can be reimbursed up to \$1,750. If the player does not make the regular season roster the team does not have to reimburse them more than \$250.
- If the player has access to a car within 500 miles of the team market the player cannot opt to be reimbursed for the cost of shipping the car without the team's consent

Rest-of-Season Contracts after 90th day of the season or 7 day contracts Players are entitled to a maximum reinbursement of \$100 for local transportation

Odd number of Players recieving access to a car or reimbursement for rental costs

- Team will provide the "extra player" with either access to a care alone or reimbursement for a rental car up to \$4,000
- If this happens during Training Camp, the player will be eligible to receive up to the maximum reimbursement of \$500 if the player makes the regular season roster they can then be reimbursed up to \$3,500 (up to the \$4,000 maximum)
