

CBA ARTICLE XIX: OFF SEASON TOURS AND TOURNAMENTS

SECTION 1: PARTICIPANTS AND COMPENSATION

At any time during the term of this agreement, **the WNBA may organize a team or multiple teams to participate in Off-Season games, tours or tournaments.**

Playing Requirements:

A player is required to play in these games, tours or tournaments if:

- She is invited by the WNBA to participate **AND** does not have an Off-Season Playing Obligation, previously disclosed to the WNBA League Office in accordance with Article XVII which would prevent her from being able to participate.

Players are not required to participate if:

- They have a family emergency preventing them from playing
- They have a bona fide academic or occupational commitment that they cannot miss due to it **materially impacting the player's post-WNBA career opportunities.**

Compensation:

For participation in any Off-Season games, tours or tournaments each player will receive:

- **\$4,000 for any games tours or tournaments that last one week** (prorated if the duration is greater or lesser than one week)
- **If the game, tour, or tournament only consists of one game players will receive \$1,500** not the \$4,000

SECTION 2: NON-WNBA ENTITIES

Unless they have the consent of the WNBA, **a player may NOT play in an all-star game, tour, or tournament** that is **sponsored or operated by an entity other than the WNBA.** This **does not include** tournaments involving the **player's national team or a team which a player is playing for pursuant to an off-season playing Obligation.**
