# **CBA ARTICLE XIX: OFF SEASON TOURS AND TOURNAMENTS**

### **SECTION 1: PARTICIPANTS AND COMPENSATION**

At any time during the term of this agreement, the WNBA may organize a team or multiple teams to participate in Off-Season games, tours or tournaments.

# **Playing Requirements:**

# A player is required to play in these games, tours or tournaments if:

- She is invited by the WNBA to participate **AND** does not have an Off-Season Playing Obligation, previously disclosed to the WNBA League Office in accordance with Article XVII which would prevent her from being able to participate.

## Players are not required to participate if:

- They have a family emergency preventing them from playing
- They have a bona fide academic or occupational commitment that they cannot miss due to it materially impacting the player's post-WNBA career opportunities.

### **Compensation:**

For participation in any Off-Season games, tours or tournaments each player will recieve:

- \$4,000 for any games tours or tournaments that last one week (prorated if the duration is greater or lesser than one week)
- **If the game, tour, or tournament only consists of one game players will recieve \$1,500** not the \$4,000

#### **SECTION 2: NON-WNBA ENTITES**

Unless they have the consent of the WNBA, a player may NOT play in an all-star game, tour, or tournament that is sponsored or operated by an entity other than the WNBA. This does not include tournaments involving the player's national team or a team which a player is playing for pursuant to an off-season playing Obligation.
